





Risk assessment – SCENIHR

- ✓ The Scientific Committee for Emerging and Newly Identified Health Risks (SCENIHR) produced an opinion in March 2007
- ✓ Update ongoing, due end 2008
- ✓ Large gaps remaining in scientific evidence
- ✓ Identification of research priorities





Risk assessment – EMF-NET

- ✓ The EMF-NET project has provided support to risk assessment
- ✓ Fast Response Team
- ✓ Identification of priorities for future research
- ✓ Project closing in August 2008
- ✓ Proposed follow-up submitted under the Public Health Programme (DG SANCO)





COST BM 0704:

Emerging EMF Technologies and Health Risk Management

- ✓ Just starting not research
- ✓ Structure to help researchers in the field of EMF & Health share knowledge and information
- ✓ Encourage multi-laboratory collaboration
- ✓ Training of early-stage researchers in EMF & health
- ✓ Facilitate identification of technological change
- ✓ Identify impact of new applications on the levels and spectral nature of EMF exposure of people and possible health effects





Conclusions

- ✓ The Commission recognises that more research on the potential health impacts of EMF is needed to improve science-based policy making
- ✓ A wave of research is now coming to an end and a new wave must be prepared
- Concording advice from the SCENIHR and EMF-NET
- Enough resources must be mobilized
- Coordination with WHO needed
- ✓ The EU Framework Programme for research will be the main source of funding at the EU level.
- ✓ The Public Health Programme of DG SANCO may fund coordination activities
